Church Budget | First Baptist Church, Garland, TX

- Tithe/offerings should contribute at least 80% of total income •
- Payroll in a large church may average 40% of budget; 60% in a small church •
- Debt should be no more than 25% of budget •
- Total building expense should be no more than 30% of budget •
- Minimum of 10-20% of budget should go to missions outside of church •
- Maintain 3-6 months of reserves

The finance committee will present a budget for adoption at least one month before January 1. Fiscal year. The church fiscal year shall begin January 1 and conclude December 31. Financial records. The church will be responsible for maintaining adequate financial records at the church facilities.

A Model Church Financial Policy - LifeWay

A church should spend annually about 2% of the cost of replacing the building on maintenance. If you have a building worth \$1 million, then spend about \$20,000 on maintenance. The rest of the percentage will be spent on salaries, utilities, cleaning supplies, commercial property insurance, capital reserve funds, etc.
