Radiographs are essential during both surgical and non-surgical root canal treatment. A diagnosis, especially involving pain, may be possible without the need for radiographs but it is not possible to undertake the mechanical aspects of treatment adequately without prior knowledge of the root canal anatomy and the configuration and final radiological confirmation that treatment has been completed.

6.5 Endodontic follow-up A radiograph should be taken immediately after the root canal treatment has been completed. This applies equally to surgical and non-surgical treatment and provides a baseline reference for subsequent review of the treatment. With molar teeth it may be necessary to take more than one post-operative view.

Endodontic radiographs traditionally form the backbone of the diagnosis, treatment procedures and follow-up of endodontic cases. It is the only method whereby the dentist can "visualize" that which he cannot see or feel during the process of diagnosis and treatment.

When using films for intraoral periapical radiography, all the textbooks recommend size 1 (child) films in the vertical or portrait orientation for the anterior teeth and size 2 (adult) in the horizontal or landscape orientation for the posterior teeth.

The guidelines of the European Society of Endodontology suggest the use of CBCT in endodontics in limited cases as follows : (i) Periapical pathology diagnosis in presence of contradictory (not specific) signs and/or symptoms (ii) To confirm the causes of nonodontogenic pathology (iii) Maxillofacial trauma evaluation and/or treatment quality (iv) The extremely complex root canal anatomy evaluation before endodontic orthograde retreatment (v) The evaluation of the causes of the endodontic ...

#### Accuracy of Periapical Radiography and CBCT in Endodontic ...

Reposition the tooth into normal position (local anesthesia necessary). The tooth must often be extruded (occlusally past the bony lock prior to repositioning). Take one radiograph (2) after repositioning. Stabilize tooth with a flexible splint for up to 3 weeks.

#### Recommended Guidelines of the American Association of ...

The European Society of Endodontology (ESE) was created in 1983 from the existing European Academy of Endodontology.
